We, at Park Christian Schools would like to thank the parents making time out of their busy schedules to provide rides to and from practice and to all the games!





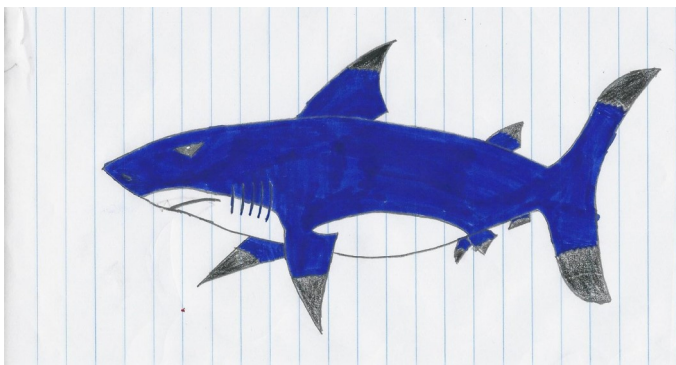
